A "Malham" sign at the Cove road entrance to the village was discussed as was a SLOW written on the road surface . PD to ask Highways.

Update from the National Trust

New House building work almost finished

130+ dead Ash trees are to be removed, other native landscape trees will be planted with the help of the MEG group.

NT to apply for Planning for 3 new car park signs on Malham Moor.

There is to be a meeting about the future of Tarn House between the FSC, NT , PC, and hopefully other interested parties, eg Julian Smith, NYCC, in late Spring.

NT is to email CW re new group that will manage the fishing on The Tarn.

NT to link with social media groups in Malham to promote any upcoming events.

PD to contact the estates manager at the NT re number and location of unoccupied houses.

YDNP update

The Listers now have a Trumper that will allow disabled access to suitable footpaths around Malham. The route from Malham to the gate before the woodland at Janet's Foss is to be modified to allow access.

Kissing Gates to be replaced with swing gates. Disabled Access along the private road in front of

Coronation Villas was discussed. Possible plans for any new bridge access were thought inappropriate.

Residents along the private road are to be consulted. DH to give Rob a list of residents.
